Listening and Vocabulary

Materials Needed:

*Story Pages

(If you would prefer to save ink then you can read the book from your computer.)

- *Vocabulary Pictures
- *Student Dictionary
- *Vocabulary page for Week I
- *Glue
- *Scissors

Time Duration:

30-45 Minutes

Lesson Plans

*Your main objective is for your students to feel welcomed and accepted into their new school or new classroom. Try to keep all the activities fun and encouraging. Students will advance at different levels so be patient and enjoy the journey of helping a child learn [nglish!

To begin:

-Give each student a My English Dictionary. Give them a few minutes to color it and look through it.

- -Lay out the picture vocabulary cards and see if the students recognize any of the pictures. If not, that is ok, just slowly go through each word and have them try to repeat the word if they can. Point to real life things if possible.
- Read through the story" My School," slowly and point out the key vocabulary throughout the story. (Read it through a few times if the students are interested.)
- Give the students their own vocabulary pictures and have them color and/or cut them out. Help the students find where the pictures would go in their student dictionary.

Differentiation: If the students are familiar with the words then have them read along when you read the story, or assign them the vocabulary first and see if they can locate where it would go in their dictionary on their own.
